Recognizes individuals, businesses, or coalitions working to make downtown Bakersfield safer, more vibrant, and economically thriving.

## **Educational Excellence**

Recognizes educators, projects, or institutions advancing educational opportunities and achievement across all levels in the community.

#### **Health & Wellness**

Honors individuals, groups, or organizations that go beyond their normal activities to promote healthy living through education, prevention, or medical services.

## Humanitarian Individual of the Year

Recognizes an individual whose volunteer efforts have made a significant and lasting impact in the community.

# **Humanitarian Group of the Year**

Celebrates a group whose dedicated volunteer work has made a meaningful difference in the lives of Bakersfield residents.

# **Emerging Nonprofit of the Year**

Recognizes a nonprofit organization (1-10 years old) for its significant impact on the community through its grassroots initiatives.

## Nonprofit of the Year

Honors a nonprofit organization for its significant and lasting impact on the community.

# Small Business of the Year

Celebrates a small business (25 employees or fewer) whose contributions, products, or services instill pride and benefit the community.

# Large Business of the Year

Recognizes a larger business (26 employees or more) for its substantial impact through volunteer work, donations, or community engagement.

## Next-Gen

Honors a young individual or group (grades K-12) with exceptional citizenship and community involvement.

# Young Professional of the Year

Recognizes an individual (ages 18-40) whose contributions have significantly enhanced the quality of life in Bakersfield.

#### Business Person of the Year

Honors a local business owner or manager whose work has made a lasting positive impact on the community.

# Harvey L. Hall Lifetime Achievement

Presented to a long-standing community leader (age 55+) who has made an enduring impact on Bakersfield and its residents.
